## COMMUNITY

Bowling Green is a college community of nearly 32,000 located 20 miles south of Toledo in a rich agricultural area. Bowling Green State University (approximately 17,000 students) enhances the intellectual, cultural and recreational opportunities of the community.

## SCHOOL/FACULTY

Bowling Green High School is a public, 4-year comprehensive high school. The 2017-2018 enrollment is 972 including 97 Bowling Green students enrolled in vocational programs coordinated by Penta Career Center. The Library Media Center houses nearly 16,000 volumes as well as access to the Internet, computerized magazine and newspaper databases, and other electronic resources. Bowling Green High School is accredited by the Ohio Department of Education. The school is staffed with 62 teachers, 3 school counselors, 3 administrators, and 24 support personnel including 2 PhD conferees, 1 EdD conferee, 1 EdS conferee, 42 educators with master's degrees and 20 with bachelor's degrees.

## ATHLETICS

Bowling Green High School offers 13 boys and 12 girls' interscholastic varsity sports as a member of the Northern Lakes League and the Ohio High School Athletic Association.

## HIGH SCHOOL VISITATIONS/COLLEGE FAIR

College admission representatives may schedule a high school visit by calling or writing to the Counseling Office. Bowling Green High School participates in the Northern Wood County College Fair each fall and College Preview Night at Owens Community College each spring.

## CURRICULUM

Bowling Green High School offers honors, accelerated and advanced placement, college preparatory curriculum, and pre-vocational general courses. AP examinations are available in all core academic areas. Penta Career Center offers over 30 junior and senior vocational programs, as well as hosting a Sophomore Exploratory program. College Credit Plus is a program available to eligible students who wish to enroll in college courses for high school and/or college credit.

Weighted system for GPA is on a 4.0 scale. GPA is computed by quality points divided by credits attempted in all courses except for courses taken on a P/F basis that receive a P or for courses taken in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Social Studies (5):** Hn World Culture Studies B (First offered in 09-10) (Not offered to the Class of 2016 or after), Hn World History (First offered to Class of 2018), Hn American History (Not offered to the Classes of 2015-2019) or Hn American Studies (Not offered to the Class of 2015 or after), AP American History (First offered in 2015-16), Geopolitics.

**Science (4):** Hn Science 9 (First offered in 2013-14), Hn Biology, AP Chemistry, and AP Biology (First offered in 2014-15).

**Mathematics (6):** Hn Geometry 9, Hn Algebra II/Trigonometry, Hn Pre-Calculus, Calculus (If Class of 2011 or before) or Hn Calculus (If Class of 2012-2014). AP Calculus (AB) (If Class of 2015 or after) (Algebra I is accelerated track if course sequence began in 8<sup>th</sup> grade).

**Foreign Language (4-5):** French and Spanish I, II, III, IV and V are accelerated if sequence began in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Level V is offered upon sufficient demand.
