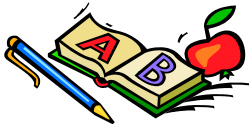


KENWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The Ohio law requires that all supplies brought to school, such as markers, crayons, watercolors, color pastels, and glue must have an approval label on them. One of the following groups of letters will appear: **ASTM**, **AST**, **AP** or **ACMI** approved. The label can be found on the back or on the bottom of the product. Please see the examples:

****HEADPHONES:** Every student, grades K-5 need to have their own individual headphones for use with the computers. SIZE- 1/8 inch jack (similar to those used with an ipod or mp3 player.)

KINDERGARTEN - Please label back pack with your child's name.

*** DO NOT LABEL SUPPLIES ***

1 set of 8 WASHABLE wide tip CLASSIC color CRAYOLA MARKERS

1 set of 8 WASHABLE fine/thin tip CLASSIC color CRAYOLA MARKERS

children's FISKAR scissors with metal blades

back pack (Make sure at least a 9x12 book will fit in it and that your child can open it easily.)

2 70 page spiral notebook

1 bx tissues

1 Pink Pearl eraser

watercolor paints

Students whose last name begins with:

(A-L) 1 bx Zip Loc Bags - Gallon Size

(M-Z) 1 bx Zip Loc bags – Quart Size

(A-L) 1 bottle hand sanitizer

(M-Z) 1 container Clorox wipes

2 fine point dry erase markers black

3 large glue sticks (no liquid roll on sticks, teach your child how to use these by twisting down the glue before putting on the cap)

****Inexpensive HEADPHONES (see note above) – Please avoid ear buds**

NO pencils, pencil sharpeners, or crayons are needed! These items will be supplied by the school.

GRADE ONE - Please label SOME supplies with your child's name.

1 dozen regular size pencils sharpened (yellow)

crayons (not JUMBO, no more than 24) - LABEL

wide tip markers (Crayola) LABEL

8 glue sticks

4" or shorter plastic shoe box (Mrs. Babcock's class) (no lid)

Ziploc freezer bags - Last Names - M-Z - quart - A-L – 1 gallon

4 sturdy plastic pocket folders (green, purple, blue, orange) - LABEL

1 7 x 10 nylon pencil pouch with zipper

*Some of these supplies will need to be replenished through the year

1 large 200ct. or greater box of tissues
