**Report to the Board of Education
Bowling Green City Schools
April 18, 2017**

On April 13, 2017, bids were received for the high school boys locker room renovations and track resurfacing project. Five contractors submitted bids for these two projects. One of the contractors bidding on the track resurfacing project did not include a bid bond and thus their bid should not be considered. The apparent low bidder for the track resurfacing project, All American Track Corporation, was interviewed by telephone on April 13, 2017. They would be able to complete the track resurfacing work during the month of June. On April 14, 2017, the apparent low bidder, The Spieker Company, for the boys locker room renovation project was interviewed at the offices of Buehrer Group Architecture & Engineering, Inc. Based upon both of these interviews both contractors are comfortable with their bid and understand the scope of work. They are also 13.1% below the estimate given at the March Board Meeting. Thus, Buehrer Group Architecture & Engineering, Inc. recommends the following contract award.

Should the Board desire, the existing track surface could be removed and a four layer new latex track surface could be installed at an additional cost of \$47,200.00. This work was bid as an alternate. Under base bid, the existing track surface will be cleaned and prepped and 2 new layers added to the existing surface. This should give another 5 to 10 years of life to the track surface. As long as there has been no bubbling occurring base bid 2 count track resurfacing should perform fine.

In closing, work on the boys locker room renovation should begin May 30, 2017, and be completed by July 28, 2017.
