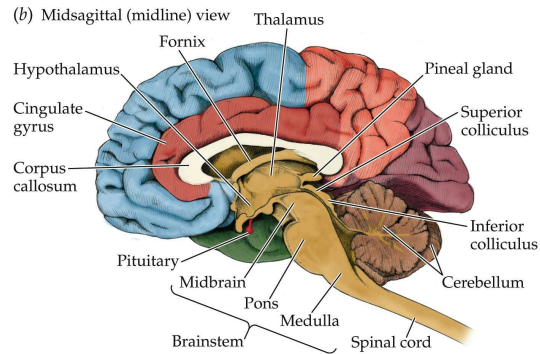

Drugs + Your Brain
